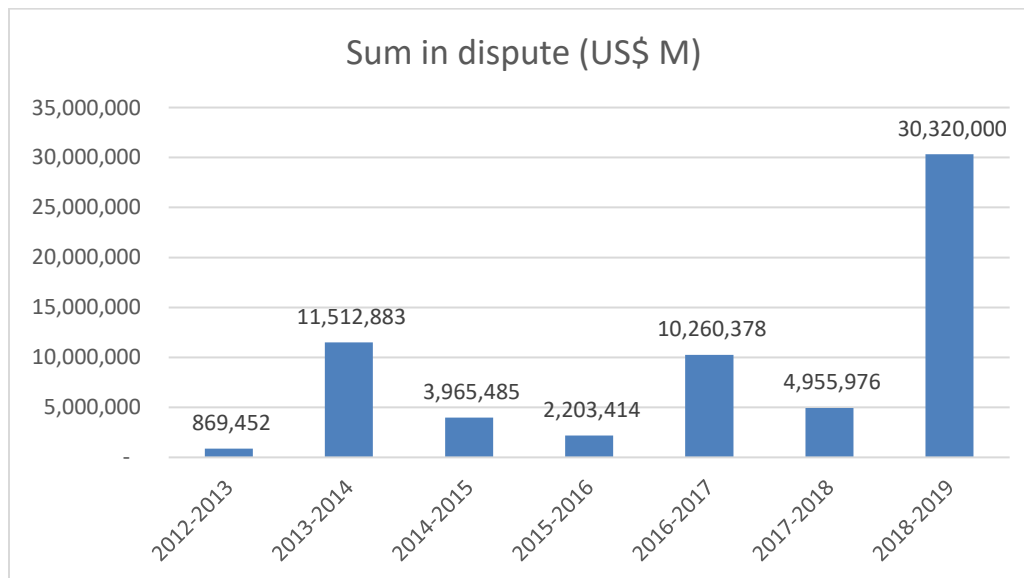
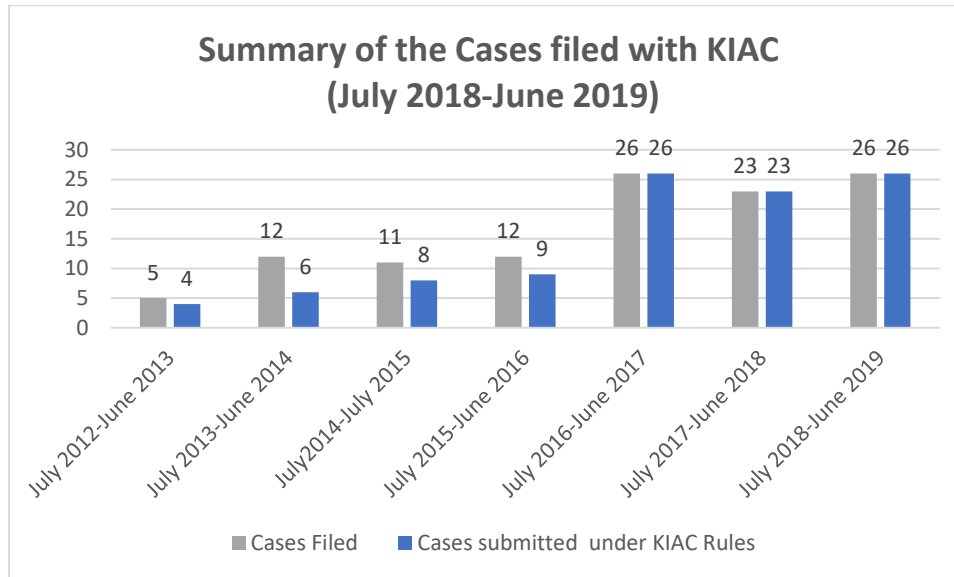
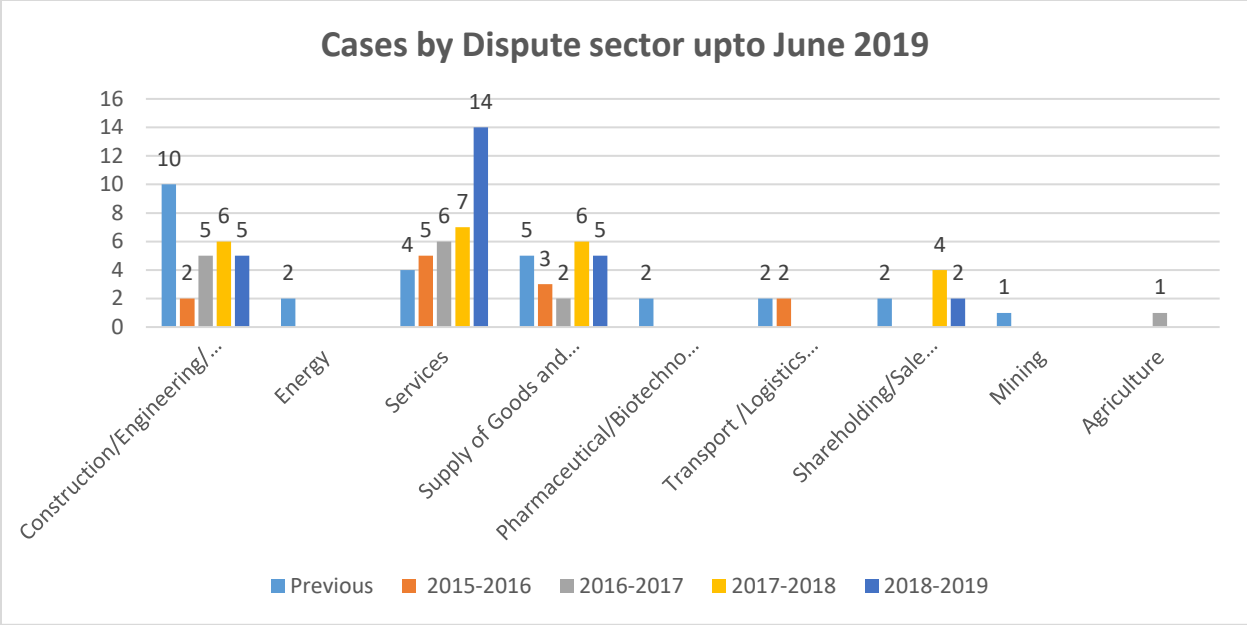


KIAC Announces another record breaking Caseload for the 3rd time in a row

It is another outstanding year for Kigali International Arbitration Centre (KIAC) as we filed 26 new cases with the highest total sum in dispute that was ever recorded in a year, amounting to US\$ 30M. The highest sum in dispute for a single administered case was US\$14M. Over the last six years, the total number of disputes is 115 cases, and the total sum in dispute is US\$ 64M.

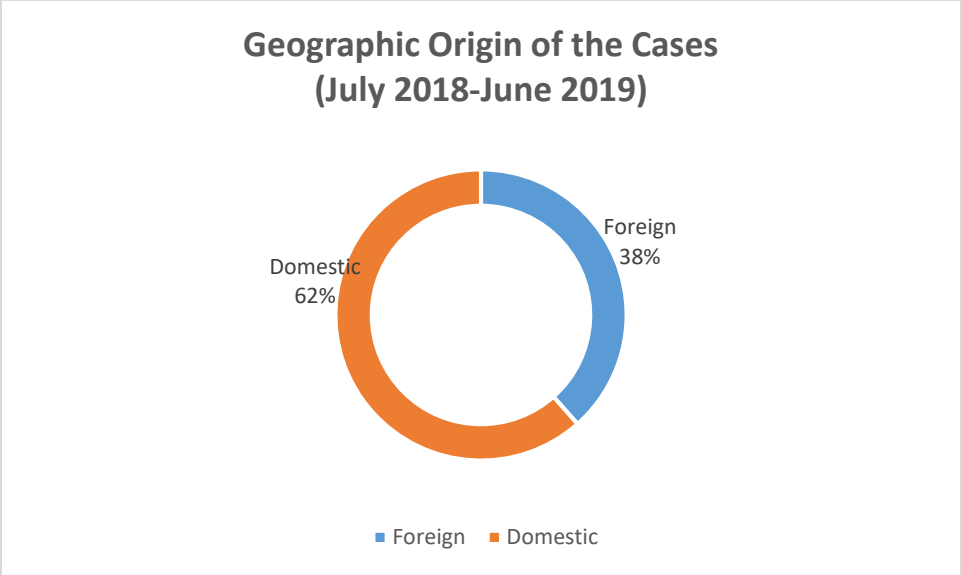




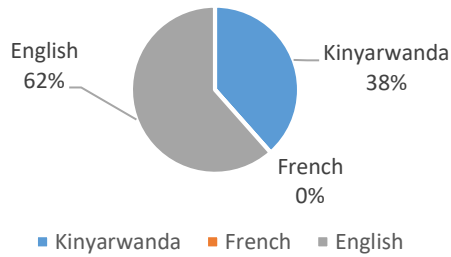
KIAC’s increasing international reach is testament of the growing confidentiality from users all over the world. This is reflected in the geographic diversity of origin of nationalities that are party to KIACs cases; notably, Burundi, China, Ethiopia, France, India, Italy, Kenya, Korea, Pakistan, South Africa, South Korea, Rwanda, Spain, Switzerland, Turkey, Uganda, USA, Zambia.

62% of the new cases filed with KIAC in the past year were domestic in nature while 38% were international. This is a testament of confidence by Rwandans in the Centre. We witnessed an increasing trend in the use of KIAC Arbitration Rules as well as KIAC office premises for Ad-Hoc arbitration hearings.

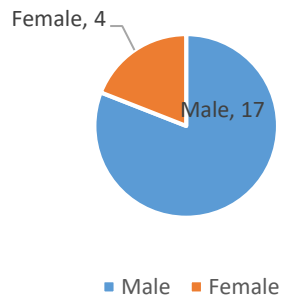

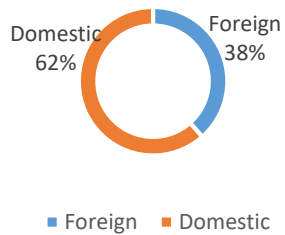
Language Used in Arbitration (July 2018-June 2019)
